

BCU 3 Star Touring Provider Requirements

BCU 3 Star Touring KAYAK Assessors:

1. Updated BCU Level 3 Inland Kayak, Sea, or Placid Water Coaches can register to deliver this award; all they need to do is contact their Home Nation requesting registration for the role.
2. Updated BCU Coaches with Moderate Water Endorsement White Water or Sea are able to request an Assessor logbook and start working through the process. In the main this involves observing and helping other qualified assessors before gaining a recommendation that it is appropriate for the aspirant assessor to take on the role.

BCU 3 Star Touring CANOE Assessors:

1. Updated BCU Level 3 Canoe or Level 3 Placid Water Coaches can register to deliver this award; all they need to do is contact their Home Nation requesting registration for the role.
2. Updated BCU Coaches with Moderate Water Endorsement Canoe are able to request an Assessor logbook and start working through the process. In the main this involves observing and helping other qualified assessors before gaining a recommendation that it is appropriate for the aspirant assessor to take on the role.

Assessor Logbook:

The initial tasks in the 3 Star Assessor Logbook require potential assessors to meet the following requirements:

1. BCU Moderate Water Coach (in the discipline detailed above)
2. Valid Coach Update Status
3. Registered BCU 2 Star Assessor
4. Date of BCU 2 Star Assessment Run

Once these initial tasks have been completed potential assessors can start to work on courses alongside a qualified BCU 3 Star Touring Assessor (in the discipline concerned), recording the evidence in their assessor logbook, until they are ready for the final endorsement element of the logbook process.

Potential providers wishing to register/complete a logbook should contact their Home Nation Coaching department. The role will be confirmed once the prerequisites have been verified, or an assessor logbook provided.
