

Notes for Providers of the 'Old' BCU WWSR Course

Providers of the 'old' BCU White Water Safety Course who wish to become Course Directors for the new BCU White Water Safety Course will be required to:

• Complete a day training module (presented within the Home Nations on a demand led basis).

The training module will run through the new WWSR syllabus and trainers notes with at least half a day spent practically on water, ensuring that providers are conversant with the safety issues, key learning points and are able to provide an accurate demonstrations.

Training Module Provider

This course can be run by appointed Home Nation Trainers.

A course authorisation number will be required and should be obtained at least 2 weeks in advance of the course.

Outcomes

- 1. Participant clearly at appropriate standard to run WWSR courses: Complete a course schedule, noting that participant(s) have completed provider retraining and should be registered as BCU WWSR providers. Send schedule to Home Nation Office.
- 2. Participant not yet ready to run WWSR courses:
 Participant should be provided with an action plan, recorded in a BCU
 WWSR Providers Log (available from Home Nation Office). Once they
 have completed the action plan they should present themselves for an
 'assessed delivery' by another BCU WWSR Provider, then forward their
 completed logbook to their Home Nation Office.
