Regional Coaching Representatives (RCR) play a vital role in supporting Coaches in each region. The RCRs form a vital link between the English Coaching Service, Coaches and Clubs and provide advice on the development and progression within the coaching scheme. It is an excellent opportunity to get more involved in the development of Paddlesport and Coaches in your region and gain a wider range of experience and skills.

RCR Key Responsibilities:

- Providing advice and signposting coach members, clubs and centres in the region, on development and progression within the Coaching Scheme
- Actively taking the lead on the delivery of English Coaching Objectives within the region
- Planning and co-ordinating a regional programme of Coach Update Forums
- Attending English Coaching Committee Meetings, Regional Development Team Meetings and Regional Volunteer forums. RCRs should report on regional coaching developments and elevate issues and concerns appropriately.
- Support the Area Coaching Representatives to fulfil their roles

- Be a qualified Paddlesport Coach
- Have detailed knowledge of the BCU Coaching Scheme
- Effective communication skills
- Organisation and administration skills
- Excellent interpersonal skills
