

BCU SAFETY TRAINING COURSES ADMINISTRATION

The following administration requirements apply to the following BCU Safety Training Courses:

- Foundation Safety and Rescue
 - White Water Safety and Rescue
 - Advanced White Water Safety and Rescue
 - Coastal Navigation and Tidal Planning
 - Open Water Navigation and Tidal Planning
- **Course Authorisation** is required, obtained by contacting your Home Nation Coaching Office
- A **Course Schedule** must be returned to your Home Nation Coaching Officer, within 7 days of the course, with the relevant certification fees. A course schedule is provided by the Home Nation Coaching Office, at the time of notification of the Course Authorisation Number.
- The **Certification Fees** are £5 for BCU Members, £10 for non-members.
- **Tutors** with the following roles can run the respective Foundation Modules:
 - Foundation Safety and Rescue Provider
 - White Water Safety and Rescue Provider
 - Advanced White Water Safety and Rescue Provider
 - Coastal Navigation and Tidal Planning Provider
 - Open Water Navigation and Tidal Planning Provider
- **Provider Ratios**
 - Foundation Safety and Rescue: Ratio 1:6
 - White Water Safety and Rescue: Minimum ratio 1:4, maximum 1:6
 - Advanced White Water Safety and Rescue: TBC
 - Coastal Navigation and Tidal Planning:
 - Ratio 1:8 BCU Coastal Navigation and Tidal Planning Provider
 - Ratio 2:12 As above + BCU Level 3 Sea Kayak Coach
(12 is a working maximum on this course)
 - Open Water Navigation and Tidal Planning
 - Ratio 1:8 BCU Open Water Navigation and Tidal Planning Provider
 - Ratio 2:12 As above + Level 3 Sea Kayak coach with 5 Star Sea
(12 is a working maximum on this course)
